ORDER

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12.05.2026

1. It is informed that the appeal of the driver/owner, challenging the recovery rights granted to the Insurance Company, has been filed as MAC.APP.423/2015 and is in the category of "*Regular Matters*".
2. This appeal along with MAC.APP.423/2015 be listed on 27th July 2026.
3. In the meantime, *Mr. Ritik Singh*, counsel for the claimant, points out that a very limited amount of *Rs. 2,50,000/-* has been released to respondent no. 1 and *Rs. 50,000/-* each to respondent nos. 2 to 6 by order dated 28th April 2015. He states that this was a case of a fatal accident and the claimants are the wife and the children of the deceased (*Yogesh Pal*).
4. Insurance Company's grounds of appeal relate only to adjustment/reduction of compensation.



5. Accordingly, since it has been 10 years of the first partial release, another amount of Rs. 2,50,000/- shall be released to respondent no. 1 and Rs. 50,000/- each to respondent nos. 2 to 6 by liquidating the requisite number of FDRs to that extent, if so necessary, by UCO Bank, Delhi High Court, New Delhi Branch.
6. The balance amount shall continue to remain in an interest-bearing fixed deposit.
7. Copy of this order be sent to the *Manager, UCO Bank, Delhi High Court, New Delhi, Branch* for information and necessary compliance.
8. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court.
