1. As per office note, e-copy of Joint Schedule of the documents filed by the plaintiff is on record. However, on perusal of e-copy of said Joint Schedule of the documents, it is found that it only contains the documents of the plaintiff and none of the documents of defendant no.1 to 6.

2. The order dated 02.05.2024 records that as per order dated 09.02.2023, the documents have been filed by defendant no.1 to 6 and the only objection raised by the plaintiff for the said documents was that the scanned copy of original documents have not been filed but only typed copy of documents has been filed. Further, the matter was also re-notified for clarification regarding filing of aforesaid documents by defendant no.1 to 6 after filing of

Written Statement and for consideration of the objections raised by learned counsel for the plaintiff. The matter was

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then re-notified on 16.07.2024. On 16.07.2024, learned counsel for the plaintiff has not raised any objections to the filing of said documents by defendant no.1 to 6.

3. At this stage, it is stated by learned counsel for the plaintiff that she has not raised any objections for the filing of the said documents by defendant no.1 to 6 as she was not supplied copy of the said documents. She submits that she will file an appropriate application for striking off the said documents from the record.

3. The order dated 25.11.2024 is perused. The relevant portion of the said order is reproduced as follows:

“As per office note, scanned copy of original documents filed by defendant no.1 to 6 vide diary no.2545427 & 2362427 were lying under objections. Learned counsel for the defendant no.1 to 6 are directed to take requisite steps to bring the same on record.

As per office note, the documents filed vide diary no.1565509 & 1565518 by defendant no.1 to 6 are still lying under objections. Learned counsel for the said defendants seeks one more opportunity to bring the same on record. In the interest of justice, no adverse order is being passed today and the last and final opportunity is granted to defendant no.1 to 6 to take requisite steps to bring the documents on record.

.....”

4. As per the aforesaid order, the defendant no.1 to 6 has filed the documents with four different diary numbers. Learned counsel for the said defendants seeks sometime to inspect the file and apprise the court in this regard on the next date of hearing.

5. Further, hard copy of the documents filed by the plaintiff and defendant no.1 to 6 are on record.



6. It is stated by learned counsel for defendant no.7 to 9 that he has not filed any documents in the present matter.
7. Put up the matter for further proceedings on 12.08.2025.
