The victim Vijay Prakash (PW-1) has clearly identified the appellant/applicant as one of the three persons who accosted him and relieved him of all his personal belongings at the pointing out of a knife, he also having been stabbed by co-convict Raju @ Tamba @ Haseen, the applicant Raheesh Alam being the driver who abandoned the victim at a proclaimed state after the commission of the crime.

Given the nature of the offences involved and the evidence which has come on record, it cannot be said that the case is unfounded.

There is no good ground for suspension of sentence.
