ORDER

1. A request for an adjournment is made by the petitioner, who appears in person.
2. The learned counsel for the respondents has drawn my attention to the order dated 08.05.2024 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court, East District, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi in Ex/Crl No. 115/20, 188/21, 14/23 and 233/24, all titled as ***Bhawna Gupta v. Mukesh Gupta***, to submit that admittedly the petitioner failed to clear the arrears of the maintenance in terms of the *interim* order dated 29.08.2018 at the rate of Rs.7,500/- per month and, therefore, in terms of the order dated 26.02.2024 of this Court, the same stood vacated.
3. In respect of the same, the learned Family Court has now granted further time to the petitioner to clear the dues and has now



listed the Execution Petitions for the appearance of the parties/payment on 08.07.2024.

4. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does clear the arrears on or before the next date of hearing before the learned Family Court, the learned Family Court, without granting any further adjournment to the petitioner, shall proceed in accordance with law in the Execution Petitions.

5. It is further clarified that the pendency of this petition shall, in no manner, affect the further steps to be taken by the learned Family Court in the Execution Petitions for ensuring execution of the orders granting *interim* maintenance to the respondents.
