1. Learned counsel for the Petitioner has handed over an affidavit dated 12.02.2025. She is directed to have the same placed on record.
2. She states that this affidavit has been drawn up to calculate the amount payable by the Petitioner to the Respondent, for the period October, 2018 till January, 2025. She states that liability for this period has been calculated at Rs. 7,500/- as directed vide interim Order dated 29.08.2018.
3. This Court notes that the interim Order dated 29.08.2018 has been unequivocally vacated by the predecessor Bench vide Order dated 26.02.2024 and 13.05.2024 and therefore, Petitioner cannot now seek to place reliance on the interim Order dated 29.08.2024, for calculating arrears.
4. Since the interim Order dated 29.08.2018 stands vacated, the Petitioner is directed to calculate the liability and the arrears as per the impugned Order dated 25.05.2018 passed by the Trial Court which awarded



the maintenance of Rs. 11,000/- per month.

5. Learned counsel for the Petitioner seeks one weeks' time to place on record a comprehensive affidavit dealing with the liability of the Petitioner with respect to arrears of maintenance for the months of May, 2018 to January, 2025 as well as for the period June, 2015 to April, 2018.

6. Learned counsel for the Respondent as well seeks and is granted liberty to file an affidavit enlisting calculation arrears of maintenance for the relevant period of June, 2015 to April, 2018 and May, 2018 to June, 2025.
