1. Application under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner, to set-aside the Order dated 23.04.2025 and restore the accompanying Petition.
2. Learned counsel for Respondent Nos.2 to 4 appears through VC and submits that learned counsel for the Petitioner had undergone Eye Surgery on 14.04.2025 and was unable to appear before the Court. He had instructed his junior to attend the Court, who suddenly fall ill and could not attend the case.
3. It is submitted that non-appearance of the counsel of the Petitioner was due to the aforesaid reasons, was unintentional and beyond their control. Prayer is therefore, made that the Application be allowed and Petition be restored to its original number.
4. For the reasons stated in the Application, Petition is restored to its original number.
5. Application is disposed of.
