At the outset, Ms. Sunita Arora, the learned counsel for the appellant, appointed by the Delhi High Court Legal Service Committee, seeks discharge in this case in view of the fact that a private counsel has been engaged. Her vakalatnama is discharged from the case.

The petitioner seeks interim suspension of the sentence on account of his brother having passed away on 20th October, 2018 and he wants to meet and be with his family in this hour of grief and also to attend such religious rituals, as may be. The factum of death of the petitioner's brother has been verified by the police.

In view of the above, the sentence of the petitioner is suspended for a period of three weeks from the date of his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.



The application is allowed and disposed-off in the above terms.
