Today, once again, an adjournment comes to be prayed jointly. The instant contempt petition is pending since 20th December, 2016 but for adjournments no further proceeding has taken place. In the larger interest of justice, one more opportunity is granted to the parties to report the amicable settlement, if any, by the adjourned date.
