For the reasons stated in the application, delay of 30 days in filing the revision petition is condoned.

The application is allowed.

Crl. Rev. P. No.598/2017

The petitioner was convicted by the trial court under Section 304-A and 279 IPC and was sentenced to undergo RI for two years, to pay a fine of Rs.4,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to suffer SI for one month for offence under Section 304-A IPC and SI for six months, to pay fine of Rs.1,000/- and in default of payment of fine, SI for one month for offence under Section 279 IPC.

In appeal, the sentence of the petitioner was modified and the petitioner was directed to suffer one year RI, to pay a fine of

Rs.4,000/- and in default SI for one month for offence under Section 304-A IPC. However, the sentence under Section 279 IPC was allowed to remain the same.

This revision is admitted for hearing.
