Heard Mr. S. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. J. Handique, learned Government Advocate for the State respondents and Mr. N.R. Sharma, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. A.K. Bhuyan, learned Standing Counsel, Assam Legislative Assembly for the respondents Nos. 1 and 2.

2. The petitioner is before this Court by assailing the show cause notice dated 19.12.2025 issued by the Assam Legislative Assembly Secretariat, whereby the authorities concerned proposed to terminate the contract of the petitioner and recovery of alleged amounts in the future including the security deposit by initiation of blacklisting proceedings. The petitioner was aggrieved that this proceeding was initiated without any basis in the report by the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Guwahati. Copies of which were never served to the petitioner prior to issuance of show cause notice. Accordingly, the petitioner

approached this Court. By order dated 05.01.2026 the respondents were directed to serve a copy of the report of the Assistant Labour Commission, Guwahati to the petitioner within two working days thereafter, the petitioner permitted to file his reply to the show cause notice.

3. In deference to the said order the copies of the report have been submitted and the reply has also been furnished by the petitioner. Under such circumstances, since the grievance of the petitioner stood redressed no further cause survived in the writ petition. Accordingly, this writ petition stands closed at this stage without issuance of any further orders.

4. The order dated 05.01.2026 stands merged.

5. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of.
