Heard Mr. S. Nawaz, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D.P. Goswami, learned Addl. P.P. appearing for the State respondent.

2. This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 has been filed by the petitioner, namely, Sultan Abbash, Azahar Uddin, Fakar Uddin, Mubajjim @ Muajjem Hussain, Asma Khatun, Aklima Khatun, seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Juria P.S Case No. 277/2025 registered under Section 329(4)/118(2)/308(4)/351(2)/3(5), BNS, 2023.

3. The allegation in the FIR dated 14.11.2025 which about the accused persons trespassing into the house of the informant and causing assault leading

to injuries and also snatching away some money and some gold ornaments.

4. Mr. Nawaz, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one Sultan Abbash, petitioner no.1, had lodged an FIR against six accused persons with similar allegations of assault etc.

5. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he prays for some interim protection for the petitioner nos.5 and 6, who are women.

6. Call for the case diary along with the medical report. Accepting the said prayer.

7. However, considering that aspect of the matter, it is directed in the **interim**, in the event of their arrest of the petitioner nos. 5 and 6, namely, **Asma Khatun, Aklima Khatun**, is hereby allowed to go on pre-arrest bail of **Rs. 25,000/- each** with one surety of like amount **each** to the satisfaction of the arresting authority, and subject to the following conditions that:-

- (i) That the accused petitioners shall co-operate with investigation.
- (ii) That the accused petitioner shall not hamper or tamper with evidence.
- (iii) That the accused petitioners shall not intimidate the informant and shall not try to influence the witnesses and the informant.

6. Violation of any bail conditions will entail cancellation of the bail.

7. List this matter again on **22.01.2026**.
