Heard Mr. D. Bora, learned counsel for the applicant-appellants and Ms. S.H. Borah, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the opposite party-respondent no. 1, State of Assam.

2. This interlocutory application under Section 430, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is preferred seeking suspension of the execution of the sentence passed against the

applicant-appellants and for their release on bail.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 06.03.2026.

4. As Ms. Borah, learned Additional Public Prosecutor has appeared and accepted notice for the opposite party-respondent no. 1, State of Assam, formal notice need not be issued to the said opposite party-respondent. Mr. Bora, learned counsel for the applicant-appellants shall furnish an extra copy of the application along with the annexures, to Ms. Borah within 2 [two] working days from today.

6. The State is to ensure that its objection, if any, is filed on or before the returnable date.
