Heard Mr. P Kataki, learned counsel for the appellant, who submits that the instant appeal is directed against the judgment and order dated 20.12.2025 passed by the learned Sessions, Chirang in Sessions Case No. 33/2023 filed by

the appellant whereby he has been convicted under Section 302 of the IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life along with fine of Rs.50,000/- with a default clause. The learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant has also been convicted under Section 326 of the IPC and sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for 7 (seven) years with fine of Rs.20,000/- and also further convicted under Section 380 of the IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 3 (three) years with fine of Rs.20,000/- with a default clause. Also the sentences except for the fine have been directed to run concurrently.

Issue notice to the State.
