Heard Mr. S.R.A. Naser, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. B. Sarma, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing for the State respondent.

This anticipatory bail application under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 has been filed by the petitioner, namely, **Sri Debajit Bonia**, seeking privilege of pre-arrest bail, apprehending his arrest in connection with **Majuli P.S. Case**

No. 03/2026 (G.R. Case No. 09/2026) under Sections 303(2)/ 118(2)/ 3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a preliminary enquiry has been conducted by the Department itself wherein the petitioner has appeared and participated. The learned counsel for the petitioner has further referred to a duty chart annexed to the petition to show that the petitioner has been continuously discharging his duties prior to, on the date of incident and even thereafter. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be necessary for investigation of the case.

The learned APP has objected to the prayer of pre-arrest bail stating that there are serious allegations against him, and specific acts have also been attributed to him in the FIR itself.

Call for the case diary. List the matter again on 12.02.2026.

In the meantime, it is provided that in the event of his arrest in connection with this case, the petitioner namely, **Sri Debajit Bonia** be released bail, on furnishing a bond of Rs. 20,000/ with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

Further continuance of the interim protection granted to the petitioner would be decided on receipt of the case diary.

It is provided that the petitioner shall appear before the I.O. on or before 02.02.2026 and shall cooperate with the investigation as and when necessary.

It further provided that the petitioner shall not hamper or tamper with the evidence of the case in any manner.

List the case accordingly on **12.02.2026.**
