Heard Mr. B.D. Konwar, learned senior counsel assisted by Ms. S. Barua, learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that more than 131 documents have been relied upon by the Bank authorities so as to arrive at a conclusion that the charges brought against the petitioner have been proved. However, those documents were never furnished to the petitioner during the enquiry proceeding. It is also the submission of Mr. Konwar that the documents are available in the departmental records and, therefore, inspection of the records with a direction to furnish those documents, would be called for in this case.

Mr. S. Chamaria, learned counsel for the respondent Bank submits that the records are not readily available with him but the same can be produced within a week's time.

In view of the above, let this writ petition be listed for hearing again on 01/10/2024, as a fixed item, on which date, the departmental records shall be produced by Mr. Chamaria.
