ORDER

Date : 08-06-2018

It is stated that this writ petition has been preferred against the order dated 20.06.2014 by which the petitioner was dismissed from service.

Mr. S Chamaria, learned counsel for the respondent Bank makes a proposal that the petitioner had submitted an appeal against the order of dismissal, but the said appeal was rejected on a technical ground that it was filed beyond the period of limitation.

Accordingly, Mr. Chamaria makes an offer that in the event the petitioner desires, the appeal filed by him would be considered on merit by the authorities.

Mr. R Saloi, learned counsel for the petitioner is not agreeable to such proposal. It is also taken note of that till date no affidavit has been filed by the respondent authorities.

As the matter is of the year 2015, a last opportunity is given to the respondent Bank to file their affidavit. In the event, the affidavit is not filed by the next date fixed, the matter shall proceed against the respondent Bank in the absence of their affidavit.

Further by the next date fixed, the records of the disciplinary proceeding shall also be produced before this Court.
