Heard Mr. N. K. Kalita, learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that by filing this writ petition, the petitioner has sought for a direction to the respondent authorities concerned to pay the outstanding bill amounting to Rs.1,96,72,000/- within a stipulated time. The learned counsel submits that the said amount is towards supply of hand sanitizer during the COVID times. The learned counsel submits that on submitting an RTI application before the Health Department, the petitioner has been informed that the amount should be paid by the Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council. In this connection, he has drawn attention of this Court to Annexure – 8 of the writ petition.

In view of above, issue notice of motion returnable by four (4) weeks.

Ms. B. Bora, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of Mr. D. Upamanyu, learned Standing Counsel, Health Department, who represents the respondent Nos. 1, 2 & 4 and Mr. J. Chutia, learned Standing Counsel, KAAC, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos. 3 & 5.

Petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 6 by speed post within a period of three (3) working days.

Petitioner to serve requisite extra copies of the writ petition to the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents, within three (3) working days.

List the matter again on 24.03.2026.

Pendency of the writ petition shall not be a bar for the respondents to mitigate the grievance of the petitioner.
