1. Heard Mr. N.K. Kalita, learned counsel for the petitioner; Mr. D. Upamanyu, learned Standing Counsel, Health & Family Welfare Department for the respondent nos. 1, 2 & 4; and Ms. S. Kemprai, learned Standing Counsel, KAAC for the respondent nos. 3 & 5.
2. Perused the Office Note dated 20.03.2026 wherein it is reported that the petitioner has not taken steps for service of notice upon the respondent no. 6 in terms of the order dated 13.02.2026.
3. Mr. Kalita, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he may be granted another opportunity to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent no. 6 in deference to the order dated 13.02.2026.
4. The petitioner is allowed to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent no. 6 by speed post within 3 [three] working days from today.
5. By an Order passed today in I.A.[C] no. 560/2026, the party-respondent no. 7 has been newly impleaded and the petitioner has been directed to file an amended Cause-Title

within 3 [three] working days from today for corrections in the Cause-Title and in the CIS.

6. Ms. Kemprai, learned Standing Counsel, KAAC has submitted that she would appear and accept notice on behalf of the newly impleaded party-respondent no. 7.

7. The learned counsel for the petitioner shall furnish an extra copy of the writ petition along with annexures to Ms. Kemprai within 3 [three] working days from today for service of notice upon the newly impleaded party-respondent no. 7.
