Heard Shri S. Borthakur, learned counsel for the applicants-appellants, who has filed this application under Section 430 of the BNSS, 2023 praying for suspension of sentence and to allow him to go on bail against the impugned judgment and order dated 12.12.2025 passed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, FTC, Sivasagar in Case No. Sessions 41 (S-S) 2020 convicting and sentencing the appellant no.1 to undergo rigorous imprisonment for Life under Section 109 of the IPC r/w Section 302 of the IPC and to pay fine of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) only in default of payment of fine to undergo simple imprisonment for 02 (two) months and the appellant no.2 to undergo rigorous imprisonment for Life under Section 302 of the IPC and to pay fine of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) only in default of payment of fine to undergo simple imprisonment for 01 (one) year and to pay fine of Rs.300/- (Rupees Three Hundred) only in default of payment of fine to undergo simple imprisonment for 01 (one) month under Section 341 of IPC.

The connected appeal has been admitted today.

Let notice be issued, returnable by 6 (six) weeks.

Shri R.R. Kaushik, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, Assam accepts notice on behalf of the State respondent.

Let steps be taken for service of notice upon the respondent no.2 in the

manner prescribed within 2 (two) days from today.

List this matter after 6 (six) weeks with report on receipt of the records as well as service upon the respondent no.2.

By the next date, the respondents may file objections, if so advised.
