Heard Mr. J.I. Borbhuiya, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. S.R. Baruah, learned Junior Government Advocate, Assam for all the respondents.

The petitioner has stated that he is the registered owner of two nos. of vehicles bearing Registration nos., AS-25-U-8656 [Indigo] and AS-01-FW-9596 [Bolero]. The petitioner has further stated that during the years 2023-2024, the respondent authorities, more particularly, respondent no. 6 had taken the said two vehicles on hire for the purpose of use in law and order/public order duties. The petitioner has stated that he submitted bills as per the prescribed hire rate of the Government before the respondent authorities. As per the petitioner, a total bill amount of Rs. 12,98,884/- has remained outstanding till date. As despite approaches being made, the said amount has not yet been released to the petitioner, the petitioner has approached this Court seeking relief.

Issue notice, returnable on 18.03.2026.

As Mr. Baruah, learned Junior Government Advocate, Assam has appeared and accepted notices for all the respondents, formal notices need not be issued to the said respondents. Mr. Borbhuiya, learned counsel for the petitioner shall furnish requisite nos. of extra copies of the writ petition along with the annexures, to Mr. Baruah, within 2 [two] working days from today.

The respondents shall file its response as regards the claim of entitlement of the petitioner for the amount of Rs. 12,98,884/- before the returnable date.
