Mr. H. Islam, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. B. Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions in the matter and also prayed for 2 (two) days time to take steps for service of notice on the respondent.

2. It appears that that the respondent as plaintiff had filed T.S. No.43/2018, for eviction of the petitioner which was decreed and the petitioner had unsuccessfully challenged the decree of the Trial Court before the learned First Appellate Court against the decree of eviction passed against the petitioner for eviction as tenant from the tenanted premises and recovery of arrear rent.

3. The present application to challenge the First Appellate order of dismissal of appeal and the Trial Court order for eviction has been assailed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.
