Heard Shri A.M. Khan, learned counsel for the petitioner, who is aggrieved by non-finalisation of his prayer for demarcation of his plot of land.

It is contended that earlier notice were issued for such demarcation which however did not culminate in any actual exercise of demarcation. He has also drawn the attention of this Court to the notice dated 05.01.2026 whereby the date was fixed on 30.01.2026. However, nothing was done on the said date and no further date is made known to the petitioner.

Let notice be issued, returnable on 20.03.2026.
