Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

Learned counsel Mr. R.S. Chauhan appears on behalf of the petitioner. Heard.

Perused the records.

Perusal of an earlier office note dated 23.02.2024 reveals that notice was issued to the respondent No. 7 by way of registered post with A/D on 22.02.2024.

However, from a perusal of the recent office note dated 03.04.2025 reveals that neither the A/D card nor any un-served notice has been received in respect of the aforementioned notice issued to the respondent No. 7.

In addition to the aforesaid, it appears that the postal track consignment details regarding the aforementioned notice issued to the respondent No. 7 are also not available at the Indian Post Website.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 7 by registered post with A/D, within one week from the date of this order.
