Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel Mr. N.R. Sarma appears on behalf of the learned Standing counsel, BTC, representing respondent Nos. 5 & 6. Heard.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the office notes dated 21.04.2025 & 15.09.2025 reveals that notice was issued to the respondent No. 7 by way of registered post with A/D on 21.04.2025.

But so far, neither the A/D card nor any un-served notice has been received in respect of the above mentioned notice issued to the respondent No. 7. Further, it appears that the

postal track consignment report regarding the aforesaid notice is also not available at the Indian Post Website.

In view of the observations made above, the petitioner is hereby directed to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 7 by way of speed post mode, in terms of the **Notification No. 85 dated 15th October, 2025 (at Flag-'N')**. The said steps shall be taken within 7 (seven) days from the date of the said order.
