The younger brother of the petitioner was killed in police firing on 25.01.2018 which took place in the Dima Hasao District. Alleging that the Magisterial enquiry ordered to be conducted in connection with the incident is not only incompetent but also vitiated by procedural irregularities, the present writ petition has been filed.
