Heard Shri Z. Khalid, learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the facts projected, the petitioner with his family was residing at Bhalukdubi in Hasila Beel area in the district of Goalpara and was evicted in June 2025. After such eviction, there was no arrangement made for the rehabilitation, resettlement or temporary shelter, for which, the petitioner had suffered immensely. He has also lost his wife in the meantime and had submitted representation for relief and rehabilitation and also for compensation for the death.

Let **notice** be issued, returnable on **01.04.2026**.
