The learned counsel for the petitioner shall serve requisite nos. of extra copies of the writ petition along with annexures, to Mr. Dutta and Ms. Das within 2 [two] working days from today.

The petitioner shall take steps for service of notice upon the respondent no. 6 by speed post within 2 [two] working days from today.
