Heard Mr. B. Chakraborty, learned counsel for the writ petitioner.

The writ petitioner herein is serving as a Constable in the Assam Police, He has approached this Court by filing this writ petition with twin grievances, viz. non-payment of subsistence allowance from May, 2011 to 10/07/2012 i.e. the period during which the petitioner was placed under suspension and secondly, for denial of promotion despite the closure of the criminal proceeding initiated against him. The petitioner, therefore, prays for a Writ of Mandamus for Redressal of his grievances.

Mr. T.C. Chutia, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam, appearing for the respondents, prays for some time to obtain instruction in the matter.
