Heard Mr. A. Matin, learned counsel for the petitioners, who submits that by filing this writ petition, the petitioners who are nominated as the President and Vice President of the School Managing and Development Committee (SMDC) of Champupara Higher Secondary School have sought for a direction to the respondent authorities concerned to approve the nomination of Members of the SMDC as per the resolution taken by the SMDC on 08.01.2026 when it held its first meeting. Referring to the order issued by the Inspector of Schools, KDC, Amingaon on 05.01.2026 (Annexure-E) the learned counsel submits that as per the said order, the Principal/Headmaster of the School is required to recommend the names of Members in consultation with the President of the SMDC to constitute full-fledged committee within 7(seven) days. Despite the same having been done, since no approval has been given, the petitioners are before this Court.

In view of above, issue notice of motion returnable by 3(three) weeks.

Mr. U. Sarma, learned Standing Counsel, Secondary Education Department accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 4 and Ms. D. D. Barman, learned Senior Govt. Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3.

Petitioners to serve requisite copies of the Writ Petition to the learned counsels appearing for the respondents today within 2(two) days.

Petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 5 by speed post within 3(three) days.

List the matter again on 30.03.2026.

Having regard to the projection made, status-quo as on today shall be maintained till the next date.
