Heard Mr. S. C. Biswas, the learned counsel for the appellant. Also heard Mr. P. S. Lahkar, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This appeal under Section 415 of the BNSS, 2023 has been preferred by the appellant, Samir Ali impugning judgment and order dated 19.12.2025, passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, POCSO, Kamrup (M) in Sessions (Spl) Case No. 127/2025, whereby the appellant has been convicted under Section 8 of the POCSO Act and has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 3 years and to pay a fine of Rs. 10,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to undergo further rigorous imprisonment for 3 months.

I have gone through the grounds stated in the memo of appeal. This appeal is admitted.

Let the records of Sessions (Spl) Case No. 127/2025 be called for from the Trial Court.

Let also notice be issued to the respondent no.2.

The appellant shall take steps for issuance of notice upon respondent no.2 by speed post as well as by usual mode within 7 days from the date of this order returnable on 15.07.2026.
