3. The case of the petitioner herein is that the petitioner's

husband sustained grievous injuries due to an attack by a person on 11.06.2023 at about 6:00 PM near Khutabari Lakhimandir Pachmile under Dhupdhara Police Station. The husband of the petitioner expired, and in that regard, a case was registered being Dhupdhara P.S. Case No.43/23 under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioner submitted a representation to the Member Secretary of the Assam State Legal Services Authority for grant of compensation in terms with the Assam Victim Compensation Scheme, 2012. The same having not been considered, the petitioner has approached this Court.

4. The respondents herein, and more particularly, the Respondent Nos.3, 4 & 5 shall place before this Court on the next date as to whether any steps have been taken pursuant to the representation submitted by the petitioner on 07.08.2025.
