Issue notice making it returnable on 18.05.2026.

2. Mr. A. Bhattacharya, the learned Standing Counsel appears on behalf of the respondent No. 1 and Mr. H. Sarma, the learned Additional Senior Government Advocate appears on behalf of the respondent Nos. 2 and 3.
3. Extra copies of the writ petition be served upon the respective counsels during the course of the day.
4. As regards the respondent No. 4, the petitioner is directed to take steps by way of Speed Post by 02.04.2026.
5. The case of the petitioner herein is that the petitioner is the power of attorney holder of one Sri Nazibur Rahman. It is the case of the petitioner that on account of certain disputes between the said Sri Nazibur Rahman and the respondent No. 4, a request was made for carrying out a demarcation of the

land admeasuring 4 Kathas 15.30 Lechas covered by Dag No. 65 (New) under K.P. Patta No. 41 (New) of Village Dhalbama, Mouza- Beltola, in the district of Kamrup (M), Assam. It is the further case of the petitioner that the Circle Officer, Dispur Revenue Circle had issued an authority letter to one Dibakar Kakati, L.R.A. of Lot No. 2, along with one Rajani Talukdar S.K., to accompany the Investigating Officer in Garchuk P.S. GDE No. 60 dated 17.11.2025 and Garchuk P.S. GDE No. 35 dated 20.11.2025 for identification of the disputed land covered by Dag No. 65 of K.P. Patta No. 41 of Village Dhalbama under Beltola Mouza on 23.12.2025. However, according to the petitioner, no such steps were taken.

6. Mr. H. Sarma, the learned Additional Senior Government Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 submitted that in the meantime, on account of the Model Code of Conduct being operational and the ensuing elections to the Legislative Assembly of the State of Assam, the officials are busy and such steps are deferred.

7. Taking into account the above, the respondents herein, more particularly, the respondent Nos. 2 and 3, are directed to bring on record their stand by filing affidavits.

8. In the meantime, it shall not be a bar for the respondent

Nos. 2 and 3 to carry out the demarcation of the disputed land covered by Dag No. 65 of K.P. Patta No. 41 of Village Dhalbama under Beltola Mouza and to submit a report before this Court.

9. It is observed that while carrying out such demarcation and/or identification of the disputed land, the Respondent Authorities shall not disturb the possession of any person within the disputed land.
