Heard Mr. N. Borah, learned counsel for the petitioner.

This contempt petition is preferred alleging non-compliance of the direction made in an Order dated 17.02.2026 passed in a writ petition, W.P.[C.] no. 5076/2025. It is averred that the Order dated 17.02.2026 was duly brought to the notice of the respondents.

By the Order dated 17.02.2026, the Court directed the respondent Tezpur Municipal Board to undertake a fresh settlement of the process, for the remaining period, by resorting to a process of Draw of Lots, amongst the eligible bidders who had submitted their bids in pursuance to the NIT dated 07.03.2025 and the direction was to complete the entire exercise within a period of ten days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the Order.

Mr. Borah has submitted that the period of settlement is going to expire on 31.03.2026.

Issue notice, returnable on 29.04.2026.

The petitioner shall take steps for service of notice upon the respondent by speed post, within 2 [two] working day from today.
