ORDER

Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

Learned counsel Ms. R. Saha appears on behalf of the petitioner. Heard.

Learned counsel Mr. U.K. Das appears on behalf of the respondent No. 8. Heard.

Perused the records.

A perusal of the recent office note dated 08.06.2026 reveals that notices were issued to the respondent Nos. 9 & 10 by way of speed post with A/D on 07.05.2026 and by way of usual process on 08.05.2026.

Now, regarding the aforementioned notices, this Lawazima Court observes as follows:—

(i) In respect of the notice issued through speed post with A/D, it appears that neither the A/D cards nor any un-served notices have been received by the registry till date.

However, it appears that the postal track consignment reports regarding the above mentioned notice has been generated and annexed to the case record at **Flag-'Q1'** in the

Part-II file. Now, a perusal of the said postal tracking reports reveals that notices in respect of the respondent Nos. 9 & 10 has been delivered to the addressees on 11.05.2026.

(ii) Further, in respect of the notice issued through usual process, it appears that the process server's report of respondent No. 10 has been received. This report states that the notice issued to the respondent No. 10 has been duly received by the respondent himself.

As far as the respondent No. 9 is concerned, the process server's report is yet to be received by the Registry.

From the above, it is evident that respondent No. 10 has been served through both speed post and the usual process, while respondent No. 9 has been served via speed post. Accordingly, it may be said that **service of notice upon the respondent Nos. 9 & 10 has been completed.**

In view of the above, the matter may be placed before the Hon'ble Court.
