Heard Mr. MH Ahmed, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. P. Borthakur, learned Addl. P.P., Assam appearing on behalf of the State respondent.

This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 praying for grant of pre-

arrest bail to the accused/petitioners, namely, Nazmul Hoque @ Najmul Haque who is apprehending arrest in connection with the Dalgaon P.S. Case No. 41/2026, under Sections 103(1)/118(2)/190/191(2)/324(4)/329(3) of the BNS, 2023.

It is submitted by Mr. Ahmed, the learned counsel for the petitioner that there is a civil dispute is going between the parties and out of that, there was a quarrel between the parties wherein some persons were involved but the petitioner is not at all involved in the alleged offence as he is working as a Gaonburha and his name is mentioned in the FIR as he could not stand on behalf of the informant in the said quarrel. However the petitioner is ready and willing to extend his cooperation in further investigation of the case, if he is granted with some interim protection.

Mr. P. Borthakur, the learned Addl. P.P., Assam submitted in this regard that the petitioner may be the Gaonburha but his name is mentioned in the FIR, as per which three persons sustained grievous injuries, out of which one person had already died and the condition of two others are still critical. Accordingly, the learned Addl. P.P., Assam insisted to call the case diary to know the actual fact of the case.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for both sides, let the case diary be called for, fixing the matter on 30.03.2026.
