Heard Mr. H. Baruah, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Ms. G Swami, learned Standing Counsel for the Assam Plains Tribes Development Corporation Ltd and Ms. N Dey, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. R Dhar, learned State Counsel for the respondents no. 1 & 3.

The petitioner is before this Court with two different prayers. The first prayer is for a direction to release the arrears of salary amounting to Rs. 4,77,894/- (Rupees Four Lakh Seventy-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Four only), and the second prayer is for a further direction to the respondents to consider the claim for promotion to the next higher post.

Pleadings have been exchanged in the matter.

Today when the matter was called up, learned Standing Counsel for the Assam Plains Tribes Development Corporation Ltd has placed before the Court 2

(two) communications dated 24.01.2025 and 21.02.2025. These communications reveal that the payment found to be due to the petitioner towards her arrear claim has been released to her Bank Account No.10707387048. The communication dated 24.01.2025 reflects that an amount of Rs.1,20,490/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty Thousand Four Hundred Ninety only) was released to the petitioner in her said bank account and by communication dated 21.02.2025 an amount of Rs.3,57,404/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Fifty Seven Thousand Four Hundred and Four only) was released to the petitioner's bank account.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not posted with such instructions and craves leave of this Court to complete his instructions in the matter.

Be that as it may, since there are 2 (two) prayers in the writ petition and one is stated by the respondents has been resolved, let the matter be listed for further hearing in the month of August, 2025.
