Heard Mr. M Saikia, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners.

2. Issue notice upon the respondent Nos.1 and 2 making it returnable on 08.06.2026. For the present, this Court is not inclined to issue notice upon the other respondents which shall be considered if need arises at the later stage.

3. Mr. RKD Choudhury, the learned Dy.SGI accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 and 2. Extra copies of the writ petition be served upon him during the course of the day.
4. The petitioners herein are claimants in respect to an Award passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal No.1 Kamrup(M) Guwahati in MAC Case No.243/2017. The accident which occurred was due to a vehicle which is registered in the Kingdom of Bhutan bearing Registration No.BP-2A/5737 within the territorial jurisdiction of India.
5. The petitioners herein are aggrieved on account of the non-satisfaction of the said Award dated 10.12.2021 passed in MAC Case No.243/2017 on the ground that the Award is not being executed inspite of there being an agreement between the Governments of the Peoples' Republic of Bangladesh, the Kingdom of Bhutan, the Republic of India and Nepal in respect to the Motor Vehicles Agreement for the Regulation of Passenger, Personal and Cargo Vehicular Traffic.
6. Taking into account the above, this Court would like to know the stand of the respondent Nos.1 and 2 as to how the Award dated 10.12.2021 passed in MAC Case No.243/2017 can be implemented in terms with the Motor Vehicles Agreement for the Regulation of Passenger, Personal and Cargo Vehicular Traffic.
7. The affidavit be filed on or before 01.06.2026.
