ORDER

Date : 01.04.2026

- 1.** Heard Ms. D. Das, the learned counsel for the applicant.
- 2.** This Interlocutory Application has been filed by the applicant in connection with the Interlocutory Application No.469/2026 airing out of I.A. (Civil)/3026/2025 in connection with L.A. Appeal bearing No. 5153/2025 praying for rectification of a typographical error, which has crept in the order dated 20.03.2026 in I.A. (Civil)/469/2026.
- 3.** Since the error which has been pointed by the learned counsel for the applicant is in connection with date of disposal of Interlocutory Application i.e. I.A. (Civil)/3026/2025 only, the notice to the opposite party in this Interlocutory Application is waived.
- 4.** The learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the Interlocutory Application for condoning the delay in preferring the connected appeal i.e., I.A.(Civil)/3026/2025 was disposed of by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 20.02.2026. However, in Paragraph No.2 of the order dated 20.03.2026 in I.A. (Civil)/469/2026 it has been mentioned as 28.02.2026 in place of 20.02.2026. She submits that as the same appears to be typographical error, the said error is required to be rectified.
- 5.** I have considered the submission made by the learned counsel for the applicant as well as gone through the materials on record.

- 6.** On perusal of the records, it appears that the I.A.(Civil) 3026/2025 was disposed of by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 20.02.2026, hence, it appears that in Paragraph No.2 of the order dated 20.03.2026 passed in I.A.(Civil)/469/2026, the date of disposal of the I.A.(Civil)/3026/2025 has been wrongly mentioned as 28.02.2026.
- 7.** Since, the same appears to be an inadvertent typographical mistake, the same is required to be corrected.
- 8.** Accordingly, the date "28.02.2026" mentioned in line No. 8 and line No. 11 of the Paragraph No.2 of the order dated 20.03.2026 passed in I.A. (Civil)/469/2026 shall be read as 20.02.2026 instead of 28.02.2026.
- 9.** This Interlocutory Application is accordingly, allowed and disposed of.
