Heard Mr. U. P. Chaliha, learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that by filing this writ petition, the petitioner has sought for direction to the respondent authorities concerned to allow him to count the period of service rendered by him on contractual basis towards the seniority in the post of Graduate Teacher, upon the petitioner having been regularized.

Mr. S. M. T. Chistie, learned Standing Counsel, Secondary Education Department, at this stage, submits that in order to be eligible for consideration for counting his contractual service for seniority, one has required to have a certain number of years of service on regular basis, which the petitioner otherwise do not have and therefore the petitioner cannot have any legitimate grievance.

It is seen that the petitioner along with others have been regularized as Graduate Teacher vide Order dated 04.02.2021 with effect from the date of his joining.

In view of above, issue notice of motion, returnable by four (4) weeks.

Ms. K. Phukan, learned Government Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No. 1 and Mr. S. M. T. Chistie, learned Standing Counsel,

Secondary Education Department, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos. 2, 3 & 4.

Petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 5 by speed post within a period of three (3) working days.

List the matter after four (4) weeks.
