School, died-in-harness on 10.10.2023 and that he was not paid his salary since 01.10.2015 till the month of October, 2023. The petitioner therefore prays for a direction to the respondents to release the salary of her late husband for the period w.e.f 01.10.2015 till October, 2023. Further, the petitioner also prays for a direction to the respondent authorities to process the current and full salary of the petitioner's husband to the petitioner in terms of the existing

Compassionate Family Pension Scheme.

In view of above, issue notice of motion returnable by 4 (four) weeks.

The petitioner shall submit the amended cause title within 2(two) days.

Issue notice to the respondent No.8 as well.

Petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent No.8 by speed post within 1(one) week.
