Heard Mr. D. P. Borah, learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioners. Also heard Mr. T. C. Chutia, learned Addl. Sr. Govt. Advocate, Assam appearing for the respondents, who submits on instructions that the writ petitioner No.1 had submitted the Tea Tribe Certificate after the last date of submitting documents i.e. 01.11.2023 whereas the petitioner No.2 did not opt for the category of Tea Tribe as a result of which, he was not considered in that category. Mr. Chutia prays for 10 days time to file a short affidavit bringing those facts on record. In view of the request made at the Bar, time as prayed for by the learned departmental counsel is hereby granted.

Issue notice of motion returnable on 23.04.2025.

Since Mr. T. C. Chutia, learned Addl. Sr. Govt. Advocate, Assam has entered appearance and accepted notice on behalf of all the respondents, no formal notice is required to be sent in this case. However, extra copies of the writ petition, requisite in numbers, be furnished to the learned Government Advocate, Assam within three days from today so as to enable him to obtain instruction and file affidavit.

The affidavit on behalf of the respondents be positively brought on record on or before 21.04.2025 by serving advance copy upon the petitioners' counsel.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, it is hereby provided that two posts of Constable under the recruitment process in progress be kept vacant, awaiting further orders that may be passed in this case.
