Heard Mr. S.I. Akand, learned counsel for the petitioner; Ms. P.R. Mahanta, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue [Relief & Rehabilitation] for the respondent no. 1; and Ms. S. Baruah, learned Junior Government Advocate, Assam for the respondent nos. 3, 4 & 5.

The petitioner is seeking disbursement of ex-gratia amount in terms of the policy of the State Government due to death of the petitioner's husband in a road traffic accident. The petitioner has claimed that she is eligible to receive the ex-gratia amount in terms of the Notification dated 31.10.2023 [Annexure-7].

Issue notice, returnable in 4 [four] weeks.
