Heard Mr. H.K. Das, learned counsel for the applicant/ writ petitioner. Also heard Ms. M. Bhattacharjee, learned State Counsel appearing for respondent Nos.1 & 2 and Mr. C. Baruah, learned standing counsel for the Accountant General (A & E), Assam appearing for respondent Nos.3 & 4.

The respondents are granted further three (3) weeks time to file their response to this Interlocutory Application as well as the Writ Petition.

Considering that this Court vide order dated 18.11.2023, in the main Writ Petition has suspended the impugned communication dated 15.07.2023, seeking recovery of an amount of Rs.10,65,081/- (Rupees ten lakh sixty five thousand eighty one) only, the impugned fresh communication dated 09.01.2025, issued on 19.02.2025, seeking recovery of Rs.10,17,201/- (Rupees ten lakh seventeen thousand two hundred one) only, shall remain suspended.

The respondents are directed to release the pension and other pensioner benefits to the petitioner, as per rules.
