Heard Mr. S. Banik learned counsel for the petitioner; and Mr. D. Gogoi, learned Standing Counsel for the Forest.

- 2.** Issue Notice, Returnable within four weeks.
- 3.** Mr. D. Gogoi, learned Standing Counsel, Forest Department appears and accepts notice on behalf of Respondent Nos. 1 to 4, therefore notices are waived on behalf of Respondent Nos. 1 to 4.
- 4.** However, extra copies shall be furnished within a period of 1 week from today.
- 5.** Steps on the Respondent No. 5 shall be taken by Speed Post within a period of 1 week from today.
- 6.** It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner

had earlier filed a writ petition, being WP(C) No. 1075 of 2025, which is presently pending before this Court, wherein the petitioner has sought a direction to the Respondents to consider his application for grant of marks obtained by him at the induction training of the Assam Forest Guards' Training School, Makum. The petitioner obtained 69.52% and had submitted a representation seeking rounding off of the same to 70%. As the said representation has not been considered, the petitioner has filed the present writ petition.

7. Accordingly, this Court is of the view that both these matters be connected, as they relate to a similar issue.

8. Therefore, let this writ petition be listed along with WP(C) No. 1075/2025 after the returnable date.
