Heard Mr. K. Mira, learned counsel for the petitioners.

The petitioners, who claimed to be the voters of Rangauti Gaon Panchayat in Hailakandi District, Assam, have filed this writ petition, challenging the election of the respondent No. 6, who has been elected as the Ward Member of Ward No. 4 of Rangauti Gaon Panchayat in the election held in the month of May, 2025, on the ground that the respondent No. 6 is disqualified to be elected as the Ward Member under Section 111(2)(a) (b) of the Assam Panchayat Act, 1994, which mandates that a person having more than two children and not possessing minimum educational qualification HSLC is not eligible to contest as Gaon Panchayat Member.

Issue notice, returnable by four weeks.

As Mr. S. Dutta, learned Standing Counsel, P&RD Department appears for the respondent Nos. 1 & 3, Mr. N. Goswami, learned State Counsel appears for the respondent No. 2 and Mr. R. Dubey, learned Standing Counsel, ASEC appears for the respondent No. 4, no formal notice need be issued to them. However, extra copies be served to them.

The petitioners to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent Nos. 5 & 6 by registered post as well as by usual process within three working days.
