Heard Mr. G. Baishya, learned counsel for the writ petitioner. Also heard Mr. P.P. Dutta, learned standing counsel, APSC, Ms. B. Musahary, learned standing counsel, Secondary Education, Assam and Ms. P. Chakraborty, learned standing counsel, Social Justice & Empowerment Department.

The petitioner in the present proceedings has raised a grievance with regard to non-adherence to the norms pertaining to making provisions for reservation to the Persons with Physical Disability in public employment. The petitioner in the above noted writ petitions is an aspirant for the post of Inspector of Schools and seeks reservation as a person suffering from locomotor disability. The post of Inspector of Schools having been advertised without providing for reservations to persons with benchmark disability, the above noted writ petitions came to be instituted.

The materials brought on record reveals that the post of Inspector of Schools has

been identified by the competent authority to be reserved for only one of the various PwD categories, i.e. hearing impaired category. The petitioner has not assailed such identification of the post only for persons suffering from hearing impairment.

Posed with the above situation, Mr. G. Baishya, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be granted 02 weeks' time to complete his instruction and take steps as may be called for in the matter.

Prayer accepted.
