Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

Learned counsel Mufidul Islam appears on behalf of the petitioner. Heard.

Perused the records.

A careful perusal of the case record reveals that the matter was previously listed before the Lawazima Court on 16.06.2026. Vide the order passed on the said date, the petitioner was directed to take necessary steps to obtain proper instructions regarding the address of respondent No. 4, and was further directed to submit those details before the subsequent Lawazima Court.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner Mufidul Islam appearing before the Lawazima Court today unable to furnish any details regarding the address of the respondent No. 4 and prays for further time to obtain relevant instructions.
