Heard Ms. M. Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Mr. H. Gupta, learned CGC appearing for the respondent nos.1 to 7; Ms. S. Baruah, learned Govt. Advocate for the respondent nos.8 to 10 and Mr. P. Nayak, learned standing counsel for the PWD appears for the respondent no.11.

2. The communication to the petitioner for permanent closing down of

unmanned level crossing no.76/6-7 which would implead transportation of goods from G.B. Gattani Industrial Complex and Baghdara Basti to Jorhat Mariani Road is assailed in this writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India alleging that the decision is contrary to the minutes of the meeting held on 06.06.2015 in the office of the Deputy Commissioner regarding railway crossings in Jorhat Mariani Centre.

3. Issue notice including notice on the prayer for interim relief returnable on 20.05.2024.
4. The respondents in the Railway department shall ensure that the affidavit is filed within the time.
5. List the matter on 20.05.2024 on which date an attempt would be made to take up the prayer for interim relief.
