Heard Mr. K.M. Haloi, learned counsel for the petitioner.

By filing this petition, the petitioner challenges the process of DPC on the ground that the petitioner being senior in the post of Reader, has not been considered on the ground of pending criminal case.

Issue notice, returnable by 4 (four) weeks.

Since, Mr. D.P. Borah, learned standing counsel, Health & Family Welfare Department appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4, no formal notice is required to be issued to the said respondents. However, requisite extra copies be furnished to the learned counsel for the respondents within 7(seven) days.

The petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon the respondents No. 5 to 10 by registered post with A/D within 7 (seven) days.

Needless to observe that promotion to the post of Professor shall be subject to the final outcome of the writ petition.
