ORDER

Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioners.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the recent office note dated 18.09.2025 reveals that notice was issued to the respondent Nos. 1, 2 & 3 by registered post with A/D mode on 09.05.2025.

Now, in respect of the aforesaid notice issued to the respondent Nos. 1, 2 & 3, it has been observed as follows:–

Respondent Nos. 1 & 3:– In this regard, it appears that the aforesaid notices have been received un-served with the following postal remark:–

“Addressee left, Returned to sender”.

Respondent No. 2:– In respect of the said notice, it appears that neither the A/D card nor any un-served notice has been received by the concerned section till date.

Despite the aforesaid, it has been observed that the postal track consignment report regarding the notice issued to the respondent mentioned above is available with the case record, which shows that notice in respect of the respondent No. 2 has been delivered on 15.05.2025.

In view of the observations made above, it may be said that **service in respect of the said respondent (i.e., respondent No. 2) has been completed.**

Further, in respect of the respondent Nos. 1 & 3, it has been observed that the respective notices have been received un-served. As such, the petitioners are hereby directed to obtain instructions regarding the present addresses of the aforesaid respondent Nos. 1 &

3, within 7 (seven) days from the date of this order.
